The 93 acre property consists of rich red volcanic soil which is fully pastured. Whilst it is currently being used for cattle grazing the gently sloping fertile soil would be suited to many farming enterprises.

The improvements include a recently renovated high-set Queenslander residence with verandas along the front and side. There is also an old second cottage which needs major renovations. There are also some old outbuildings.

The water supply is from a domestic bore and the property also adjoins Ahyah creek.

Alfred & Harriet Claringbold had three children Nell, Lilly and Norm and the property known as "Ellison Park" was the gathering centre for social events in the district.
